

Whole House Arsenic System

Colorless. Tasteless. Odorless. Dangerous. Arsenic occurs naturally in New Hampshire bedrock and comes in direct contact with household water underground. In fact, arsenic is so abundant in New Hampshire that it was commercially mined here in the 1800s.

Arsenic is unlike many other water issues that can be detected by odor, taste, spotting or staining. Even at high levels, arsenic can be detected only by a water test.

Studies indicate that long-term exposure to arsenic may increase the risks of lung, bladder, and skin cancer, as well as cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and high blood pressure. Because of its risks, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sets limits for how much arsenic is acceptable in water.



Why take chances?

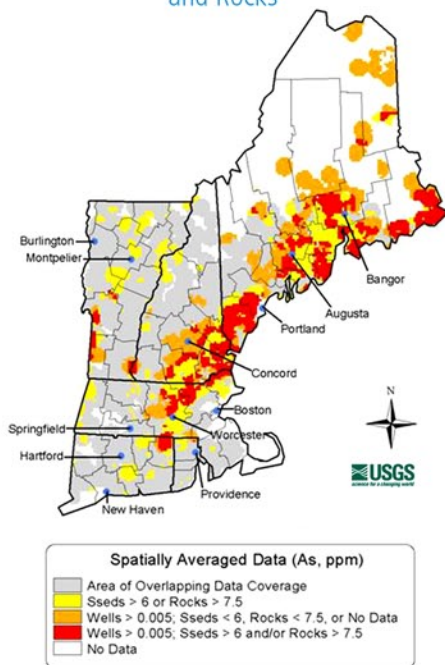

Exposure to arsenic is a special concern in New England, where soil and water frequently contains levels much higher than elsewhere in the country. Arsenic is among the top chemicals posing a threat to human health, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

How our system compares

What makes our system different is that it cleans itself of the arsenic removed from your water. Other systems absorb the arsenic in tanks or cartridges, which must then be regularly removed and replaced by the manufacturer. These “tank swaps” can become expensive and inconvenient for the homeowner.

Not every system is designed to withstand the high arsenic levels common to New Hampshire water. Our systems are built for the specific conditions of the well water and the level of water use in the home – unlike off-the-shelf filtration systems that are intended to be “one size fits all.” To keep costs down for the homeowner, many components are interchangeable and universal. Maintenance of the system takes just a few minutes every other month.

We recommend annual service checks to ensure the system is working at peak performance. Your system comes with a two-year parts and labor warranty. When service is needed, we are on call every day of the week. To give you complete peace of mind that the problem is solved, the water is tested after the installation and you are provided with the lab results.
